## **National Training Center's "Train The Troops" Program**

National Training Center's (NTC) 'Train The Troops' program is a free program offered to recently discharged military service personnel to train them for careers in the low voltage industry.

NTC recognized a need on both sides for this program. Military personnel are disciplined, motivated, dedicated, and have high ethical standards. These traits are valuable to any employer, but particularly to low voltage employers since so much trust is placed in them by their customers. The low voltage industry is growing, and most companies are constantly on the look out for quality entry-level employees. NTC developed 'Train The Troops' to help bring these two sides together.

'Train The Troops' gives each service member almost \$3,000 worth of reference material and training to introduce them to the basics of the low voltage industry. The program covers security systems, CCTV, access control, fire alarm, residential audio/video, and networking.

Students of the program receive a complete set of NTC professional reference books, 12 hours of instructor-led, live online training, and 6 months of unlimited access to NTC's online self study training program: Training Department. Students take an exam at the end of the live training program and if they pass they get free placement assistance from Wild Bullet, the industry's premier employment site. Graduates can continue learning about the low voltage industry using NTC's Training Department and professional reference books while they search for employment and after they have secured a position in the field to further their knowledge of our industry.
